the said Commodity without giving Liberty to any person or persons  
whatsoever to buy or ingrafe any goods or Merchandise brought  
to the said Townes Ports or places to be sold, but only to such persons

And provided also of this act nor any thing herein contained shall  
not give liberty to any person or persons whatsoever to export out of this  
Province any goods or commodities by the Law of this Province prohibited  
to be exported nor repeal any Law prohibiting the same.

WHEREAS there hath been two hundred and five thousand nine hun-  
dred and eleven pounds of Tobacco Expended lay'd out and disbursed  
by the upper & lower houses of this present Generall Assembly  
and by severall others the good people of this province for the  
publique good of y<sup>e</sup> same And to y<sup>e</sup> intent that y<sup>e</sup> same may be  
satisfid & paid to those persons to whom the same is Due  
**Be it therefore Enacted by the Right Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Lord Proprietary &**  
**w<sup>th</sup> the Advice and Consent of the upper and lower houses of this present**  
**Generall Assembly & y<sup>e</sup> authority of y<sup>e</sup> same That the said two hundred**  
**and five thousand nine hundred & eleven pounds of Tobacco be paid in**  
**Manner and forme as is hereafter expressed: (that is to say) to Thomas**  
**Casy sixteen hundred pounds of Tobacco: To John Lewellin two thousand**  
**pounds of Tobacco: To James Benson one thousand pounds of Tobacco: To**  
**George Robins twelve hundred pounds of Tobacco: To John Larkin five**  
**and twenty hundred pounds of Tobacco: To George Burges: Two**  
**thousand and forty pounds of Tobacco: To Marke Cordeau Twenty**
