## An Act for the Recording of Journall of y<sup>e</sup> Lower House of Assembly

Whereas it is thought good for the Benefit & Inlightning of future  
 Assemblies that a Record be kept of all proceedings y<sup>e</sup> shall pass in y<sup>e</sup>  
 Lower house of Assembly of this province Therefore Enacted by  
 The Right Hon<sup>r</sup> of Lord prop<sup>r</sup> of this province by and with the advice  
 and Consent of the upper and Lower houses of this present Generall  
 Assembly that the Clerks of y<sup>e</sup> Lower house of Assembly for the time  
 being transcribe y<sup>e</sup> said Journall within two months after the  
 Dissolution or prorogation of y<sup>e</sup> said Assembly and deliver the same  
 into the Secretaries office upon y<sup>e</sup> penalty of four hundred pounds  
 Tobacco to y<sup>e</sup> Lord prop<sup>r</sup> and the loss of his salary for his service in  
 in the Assembly: The said fine and forfeiture to be levied upon y<sup>e</sup>  
 said Clerks by the appointment of y<sup>e</sup> Gov<sup>r</sup> Generall or Governour  
 of this province for y<sup>e</sup> time being: upon certificate from y<sup>e</sup> Secretary of  
 this province for y<sup>e</sup> time being: That the said Journall as aforesaid is  
 not by y<sup>e</sup> said Clerks of y<sup>e</sup> Lower house delivered into y<sup>e</sup> Secretaries office  
 as aforesaid And it is hereby further enacted by the Authority aforesaid  
 That y<sup>e</sup> Secretary of this province for y<sup>e</sup> time being shall be enjoyned  
 to examine the Secretaries office touching the purport of this Act & make  
 certificate to the Governour or Lieutenant Generall for the time  
 being: That thereby the fine & forfeiture aforesaid may be the more  
 duly levied
