taken into their serious Consideration the great quantities of Linen  
and Woollen cloth which are brought from foreigne ports into and  
Spent in this Province & that the inhabitants of this Province for  
want of the like policy & Industry as other Countries have attained  
unto in the inventing & practicing & putting in Execution the  
making of Linen & Woollen cloth, doe yearly spend vast sumes of  
Money and quantities of Tobacco in purchasing those manufactures  
forecouthinge, & Considering the great Benifit & advantage that by the  
making of such manufactures of Linen & Woollen cloth will accrue  
to this Province & being willing to give all due Encouragement that  
may be to any person or persons what soever that will make or cause to be  
made any Linen or Woollen cloth doe humbly pray that it may be  
Enacted, And bee it Enacted by the R<sup>t</sup> Hon<sup>t</sup> the Lord Prop<sup>r</sup> by and  
with the advice & consent of the upper & lower houses of this present  
Generall Assembly & the Authority of the same, that from & after the  
publicacion hereof any person or persons what soever inhabitants within  
this province that shall make or cause to be made & woven within  
this province of the growth & manufacture of this province any  
Quantity of Linen or Woollen cloth of what kind soever such person or  
persons so making or causing to be made such Linen or woollen cloth  
as aforesaid within this province shall for his & their encouragement  
in the advancing & setting forward such manufactures here and to  
Receive from the severall & Respective Commiss<sup>rs</sup> of the severall and  
Respective County Courts within this province where the said person  
or persons so making or causing to be made such Linen or woollen  
cloth as aforesaid shall dwell and reside for every yard of Linen  
Cloth so to be made as aforesaid being three quarters of a yard broad  
at the least the sum of six pounds of Tobacco, & for every yard of  
woollen cloth so to be made as aforesaid being three quarters of a  
yard broad at the least the summe of tenne pounds of tobacco, to  
be paid & paied to the person & persons making or causing to be made
