

Further Enacted by the authority aforesaid that Joseph Freeman Carpenter who hath undertaken to do & forme & finish all & every the above said particulars according as is above expressed, and hath given security to performe the same to be paid out of the publick Treasury of this province the summe of Twenty thousand pounds of Tobacco to be paid & allowed in st. Maries, Calvert, Charles & Ann Arundell Countys or some of them, & also for the other payment to Richard Benton to be made in the same Countys. &c.

An Act for payment and assessing the
publick Charge of this province

Whereas there hath been Three hundred ninety seven thousand one hundred twenty and five pounds of Tobacco expended levied and disbursed by the upper and Lower houses of this present Generall assembly and by severall other the good people of this province for the publick good of the same & to the intent that the same may be satisfied & paid to those persons to whom the same is due Be it therefore Enacted by the R. Hon^{ble}: the Lord Prop^{ty} by and with the advice and consent of the upper & Lower houses of this present Generall assembly & the authority of the same that the said Three hundred ninety seven thousand one hundred twenty & five pounds of Tobacco to be paid in manner and forme as is hereafter expressed that is to say to Samuell Sewell of Sommer setts County two hundred pounds of Tobacco, to George Burgess of Ann Arund. County one thousand & sixty pounds of Tobacco, to Francis Jenkins High Sheriffe of Sommer setts County nine thousand nine hundred & eighty five pounds of Tobacco, to Andrew Abingdon five thousand five hundred & thirty pounds of Tob^o: to Richard Bull nine thousand four hundred and ten pounds of Tobacco to Philip Lynes eight thousand four hundred & eighty pounds of Tobacco, to Thomas Foster of st. Maries County sixteen hundred pounds of Tobacco, to Doct^r: Joseph Sompile sixteen thousand pounds of Tobacco sevenish ninety pounds of Tobacco, to Saver seven hundred & ten pounds of Tobacco, to William
