LAWS made in the time of the Government of ^{John} Copley Esq. Cap. Generall and Governour in these in and over this their Majesties Province of Maryland and ~~thereunto~~ thereunto belonging and in the Year of our Lord, 1692.

Att a Generall Assembly begun and held at the City of S. Mary's the Tenth day of May Anno Domini 1692. The fourth Year of the reigne of our Sovereigne Lord and Lady William and Mary by the grace of God of England, Scotland, France and Ireland King and Queen Defenders of the faith &c. thence continued till the Ninth day of June next ensuing. These following Laws were ordained and Enacted to the praise of God the Honor of their Majesties and the welfare of this Province. Which by the Experience and Benefit received by them are thought necessary and usefull: are therefore continued. Laws of this Province by this present Generall Assembly held at Annapolis the Twenty Eighth day of June in the Seventh Year of the reigne of our Sovereigne Lord King William the first of England &c. and in the year of our Lord 1699.
