

Whereas there have many inconveniences
this province for want of Appointing Coroners in each County
County Be it enacted by the King and Queens most Excellent
Majesties by and with the Advice and Consent of this present Generall Assembly
and the authority of the Same That the Governor for the time being do
Constitute and appoint Such person or persons from time to time to be
Coroners as he shall Judge most able and best qualified for that Office
in each respective County in the province And Be it further
Enacted by the Authority aforesaid by and with the Advice & Consent
aforesaid That the Governor give out Commission to Such persons to the
intent and purposes aforesaid and that the Same as near as may be con-
-cur with the Laws and Constitution of England and that an Oath be
-administred to every Such Coroner by appointment of the Governour of their
Entering into the said Office according to the forme of the Oath of a Coroner in
England

An Act for the Appointment of Certain Officers

Be it Enacted by the King and Queens most Excellent Majesties
by and with the Advice and Consent of this present Generall Assembly
and the Authority of the Same That the Justices of peace of every
County at the first County Court hold after Michaelmas shall
Nominate and appoint Some Inhabitant in every Hundred
Precinct who shall Execute all precepts and Warrants
directed and that in all things have the like power
said Hundred and precinct as any Constable hath or
in a Hundred or precinct in England by the Law or Custom
