

now Said Writtes their Heires and Successors the Summe of  
five hundred pounds of Tobacco for the uses aforesaid to be  
recovered as aforesaid or Two months Imprisonment without  
Baile or Mainprize **AND** be it further Enacted by the  
Authority aforesaid That whosoever being by Writt Lawfully  
Summoned and thereby required to serve as a Witness in this  
Province and shall refuse to Testify upon oath in any Case de-  
-pending whether Criminal or Civil shall forfeit to our Sovereign  
Lord and Lady the King and Queen their Heires & Successors the  
Summe of five hundred pounds of Tobacco for the uses aforesaid to  
be recovered in Manner as aforesaid or suffer Two Months  
Imprisonment without Baile or Mainprize **Provided** this  
Clause shall not extend to people called Quakers **Provided**  
That this Act nor any thing therein contained shall not extend  
or be Interpreted to extend to the prejudice of any the Lordes of  
Mannors within this Province in their Priviledges of Appointing  
Constables within their respective Mannors. **PROVIDED**  
That if any person dissenting from the Church of England shall  
hereafter be chosen or otherwise Appointed to bear the Office of  
High Constable Church-Warden or Overseer of the poor or any other  
Parochiall or Ward Office and such person shall scruple to take  
upon him any the said Offices in regard of the Oaths or any other  
matter or thing required by the Law to be taken and done in respect  
of such Office every such person shall and may execute such Office  
or Employment by his sufficient Deputy by him to be provided that  
shall comply with the Lawes on this behalf, provided always that y<sup>e</sup>  
said Deputy be allowed and approved of by such person or persons in  
such manner as such Officer or Officers respectively should by Law  
be allowed and approved. **Provided** Nevertheless That it shall  
be Lawfull for any Justice of the Peace or other Magistrate
