These are to Authorize and Impower you Immediately upon
receipt hereof to call together four or more Emisioners of your
County with the Clerk who are hereby required to sit as a Court
and during their sitting by Vertue of your Office to make or
Cause to be made publick proclamation thereby giving Notice
to all the Freemen of your said County who have within your
said County a freedom of fifty acres of Land or a visible Estate
of forty pounds Sterling at the least requiring them to appear
at the next County Court to be holden for your County at a
Certaine day within a reasonable time after such proclamation
made for electing and choosing of Deputies or Delegates to
serve in your County in a Generall Assembly to be holden
at the City of S.^t Marys the — Day of — at which time of
proclamation aforesaid the said Freemen so required to
appear or the major part of such of them as shall then
appear shall and may and are hereby authorized & required
to elect and choose four severall and sufficient freemen of your
