

100. It always that the Law shall not extend or be  
construed to make void any persons right by Act of Naturalization  
or any private Acts heretofore made relating to any private  
persons but that the same be hereby kept and preserved to them  
according to the true intent and meaning thereof any thing  
heroin to the contrary notwithstanding.

## An Act for Quieting of Possessions

Forasmuch as a good and beneficial Law, Intituled  
An Act for Quieting Possessions was made the Seaven & Twentieth  
day of March in the Year of our Lord one Thousand Six Hun-  
dred Seventy and one in this Province which by the use thereof  
hath been very much conducing to the benefit of the people  
of the said Province Be it therefore Enacted by  
the King and Queens most Excellent Majesties by and with the  
Advice and Consent of this present Generall Assembly and by  
authority of the same, That all Sales Gifts and Grants -  
at any time before the said Seaven and Twentieth day of -  
March in the Year of our Lord one Thousand Six hundred -  
Seventy and one and not after of any Lands Tenements -  
or Hereditaments within this Province by any person or persons  
whatsoever that right had to sell give or Grant such Lands  
Tenements or Hereditaments made by Writing onely with or  
without Seale shall for ever hereafter be accounted good &  
vailabie in Law to Barre the Heires or Executors of such Vendors  
or Grantors any Error in the forme onely of such
