Same That the Town Land at Oxford in Jersey
Constituted and Appointed a Town and ports by an
Act of Assembly made at a Session of Assembly
held at the City of St. Marys the one and Twentieth day
September in the Year of our Lord one Thousand six hundred
Ninety and four be again Surveyed and Laid out, that is to
say sometime before the last day of September next by
the Commissioners in the afore recited Act nominated and
Appointed bounding the Same at Low Water Mark in-
cluding the Island and so to the old bounded Trees at the
Southernmost part of the Neck and that as well in the Town
and Town as in the ports and Town of Amaranth there
be one or more places laid out and reserved as the Com-
missioners of the respective ports shall think fit for the building of
Ships and other Vessels and that the Officers of the Lord-
Proprietary for receiving the Dutys due and payable to his
Lordship be thereby obliged by themselves or Deputys thereunto
Authorized and appointed to reside at the said ports & Town
for the dispatch of Ships and other Vessels Entering & Leaving
at such ports and Towns as aforesaid **AND** be it also
by the Authority aforesaid That the two ports of Amaranth
and Oxford for the future shall be called known and
designated by the Names or Appellations of Amaranth
William Stadt, that is to say the port of Amaranth
be called by the name of Amapolis and the
Name of William Stadt and that there be
