his Majesties Subjects of this Province Shall enjoy all their
Rights and Libertys according to the Laws and Statutes of
the Kingdom of England in all Matters and Causes where -
the Laws of this Province are silent And whereas the
present Constitution of this Province being in its Infancy
will not admitt of raising a Maintenance for Ministers
by way of Tythes as in England and other places by time
brought to perfection So it Enacted by the Authority
aforesaid by and with the Advice and Consent aforesaid That
for Encouragement of faithful and able Ministers Labour -
ing in the Work of the Gospel to come into this Province
in stead thereof a tax or Assessment of forty pounds of Gold -
per poore yearly and every Year laid upon every Taxable
person within the precincts of each respochee parish in
this Province as they are now (By an Act of Assembly of -
... made att a Generall Assembly Begun and -
