=stant ports of Trade by Two Voyages or at Bell Hall  
have and enjoy the privilege of freemen during their  
residence or residing at the ports aforesaid and for en-  
=couragement of all sorts of Trademen or men of Calling  
to come and inhabit in the Town aforesaid Be it enacted  
By the Authority aforesaid That when any Baker Brewer  
Tanner Dyer or any such Trademen that by y<sup>e</sup> practice  
of their Trade may any way annoy or disquiet the  
Neighbours or Inhabitants of the Town it shall and  
may be Lawfull for the Com<sup>rs</sup> and Trustees aforesaid to  
allot and appoint to such Trademen such part or  
parcel of Land out of the present Town pasture as the  
said Com<sup>rs</sup> shall seem meet and convenient  
for the exercise of such Trade a sufficient distance from  
the said Town as may not be annoyance thereto not  
less in quantity of one Lot or acre of Land to
