

... or neglect or omit to keep their Records in good  
order and duly taken up according to the Tenor of this  
Act shall upon due proof thereof made against such Clerks  
Conviction thereof in the provincial Court of this Province  
be liable to be punished by fine of one thousand  
pounds of Tobacco or be for ever after incapable of  
bearing the Office of Clerk in this Province either or  
both punishments as by the Justice before whom the  
Matter is tryed shall adjudge any Law Statute or Usage  
to the contrary notwithstanding.

An Act for the Naturalization of  
of Stephen Francis an Italian  
and George Sleycomb a German  
borne

Be it Enacted by the Kings most Excellent  
Majty by and with the Advice and Consent of this present  
Generall Assembly and the Authority of the Same  
That Stephen Francis and George Sleycomb be from  
henceforth adjudged reputed and taken as Natural  
borne Subjects of this Province and that they the  
said Stephen Francis and George Sleycomb by the Authority  
of this said Assembly are hereby enabled and adjudged to all Intents  
and purposes to Demand Challenge Aik Law & Hold  
and enjoy any Lands Tenements and Hereditam<sup>ts</sup>  
and all other Rights and Priviledges but what is herein  
expressly provided as the said Stephen and George had
