Discontinuance of  
of Cecil County Court

Whereas, Several of His Majesty's Justices of the Peace for Cecil County were chosen in the said County and sent down to Love as Delegates to the parts of Annapolis by means whereof the Court to be holden on the 2<sup>d</sup> Tuesday in March the 1<sup>st</sup> 1697 according to Act of Assembly and their Commission the said Justices on the said recited day not meeting to adjourn whereby many inconveniences and discomodities may happen to the several Suits to the said Court the several pleas process & proceedings depending in the said Court being by that means discontinued and put without day to the great Loss & Damages to the Suits aforesaid for remedy whereof and that the several Writts, pleas, process and proceedings of the said Court may be revived resolved continued and be in full force and Virtue as they were before the said discontinuance happened the Delegates of this present Generall Assembly do pray that it be Enacted, And so it Enacted by His Kings most Excellent Majesty and with the Advice and Consent of this present Generall Assembly and the Authority of the Same that all and singular pleas process and proceedings and all other matters which did depend upon the Same or had any recurrence which were in the said Court depending and arising before the said Second Tuesday in March next before the not meeting of the said Justices were discontinued and
