foreigners and Strangers for Beef and Pork. Be it
Enacted by the Kings most Excellent Majesty by and with

and the Authority of the Same that no person or persons -
whosoever either foreigner or Inhabitant shall buy Trade
or Barter with any Indian or Indians whosoever for
any flesh dead or alive Except Venison wild fowl or Deer -
=minus upon penalty of five thousand pounds of Tobacco
the one Moiety to the King for the Supports of Government
the other Moiety to the Informer or him or them that shall
sue for the Same the Said fine to be recovered in any Court
of Record within this Province wherein no Escoyn protection
or Wager of Law to be allowed
