

proves before Two Justices of the peace of any County  
or one Justice of the Provincial Court and Just Credit given  
to the same and that the Balance thereof is wholly due  
and unpaid and Certified under the hand of the Justice  
shall be sufficient Evidence as well in the Provincial and  
County Courts within this Province any Law Statute or  
usage to the contrary notwithstanding.

An Act Ascertaining what  
Damages shall be allowed  
upon protested Bills of Exch:

Be it enacted by the King's most Excellent Ma:  
by and with the advice and Consent of this present General  
Assembly and the Authority of the same That there shall  
not be allowed to any person or persons whatsoever having  
Just Cause to Implead any person or persons whatsoever -  
living or residing within this Province in any Court within  
this Province upon any Bill of Exchange drawn for any  
Sum or Sums of money whatsoever payable in England  
or elsewhere and brought hither protested more than the  
Sum of Twenty pounds & tent Damages over and above  
the Cost sued for and recovered together with Ordinary  
Cost of Suit any Law Statute usage or custom to the Con-  
trary notwithstanding.

An Act for restraining of Extortions

Whereas there hath been diverse and great
