

... shall be cut of the East of the said Wolf Road to prevent
the danger of fire or of any paying the same. Be it
likewise Enacted by the Authority aforesaid That it shall
and may be Lawfull to and for the severall Justices of the
severall and respective ~~Countys~~ Counties within this Province
and they are hereby Authorized Impowred and required
Yearly and every Year during this Act at the time of the laying
of the County Levy to raise and assess by an Equal Assessment
upon the Taxables of the said County such Sum or Sums of £¹⁰⁰
as to the Justices of the severall and respective Counties shall seem
meet and convenient and such Sums of £¹⁰⁰ raised as aforesaid
shall lay out and dispose for purchasing of Duffels or Matchcoats
and when the same is purchased shall deliver to such and so
many persons residing convenient to the Indians as y^e Justices
aforesaid shall think fitt who shall render an Account to the
said Justices at the ^{next} laying out of the Levy how such Matchcoats
delivered him or them have been disposed and what part thereof
remains in his or their possession or hands. **And** be it
Enacted that such person or persons having such Matchcoats
delivered as aforesaid do and are hereby required to deliver to
any Indian or Indians for every Wolfe or Wolfe Road not
having been paid for before one Matchcoat containing
two Yards of Duffels and give a true Account of the same
at the next County Levy as aforesaid to the Justices aforesaid
shall mark Wolfe Roads as aforesaid to prevent —
