

And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid that no Rum or Wine upon which the Duties aforesaid are assessed shall be Landed or put on Shore out of any Ship or other Vessel which shall Importe the Same or any other without due Entry there made with the Officer hereby Appointed (upon Oaths of the Said person or persons Importing into this Province any of the aforesaid Liquors) for Collecting of the Same in the Ports or places where such Liquors shall happen to be Imported as aforesaid ere before the Duty due and payable for the Same be satisfied or secured to be satisfied and a Warrant for the Landing thereof be Signed by the Officer for that purpose appointed upon pain and perill that all such Liquors Landed and put on Shore contrary to the true Intent and meaning of this Act shall be forfeited and Lost or the full Value thereof one half to be appropriated towards the defraying of the publick Navy of this Province and the other half to the Informer or him or them that shall sue for the Same to be recovered in his Majesty's Name in any of his Majesty's Courts of Record within this Province by Action of Debt Bill Plea or Information wherein no Stay or protection or Waiver of Law to be allowed And for the better Encouragement of all Masters Merchants Owners and other persons whatsoever to make due Entry and payment of the Duties Rates & Imposts raised by this Act in Consideration of Leakage and other Damage the Officer is hereby Authorized and Impowered to make Allowance and Abatement of Twenty Gallons in every Tunn Gallons of all such Liquors so to be duly Entered as aforesaid and the Said Officers hereby Appointed for Collecting and gathering the Duties aforesaid shall and are hereby
