

shall be endorsed at whose request it was sued and for a return
of such endorsement the writ shall abate and the party grieved
shall recover his cost against the Attorney that sued for the same
said writ And be it further enacted by the Authority aforesaid
that upon any presentment of the Grand Jury upon the return
of any of the beiall Laws of this Province save that for Suppressing
of Criminals and trying of them in the County Court if the party
presented confesses his Crime and Submitts to the Court the Clerk
of the Indictments shall have his fee for the same but if the
party Traverse and puts himself upon a Jury then the Clerk
shall have two hundred pounds of Tobacco fee and upon
any presentment grounded upon the Law for Suppressing
Criminals upon any Statute of England if Bill be found by
the Grand Jury the Clerk of the Indictments shall have two hundred
pounds of Tobacco fee and that upon presentment found
in the Provinciall Court the Attorney Generall shall have four
hundred pounds of Tobacco fee.
