

Enacted by the Authority aforesaid that no Sheriffs & within this Province have in their hands any publick Officers fees to collect shall presume to levy by Execution on any the Inhabitants within this Province any fees so him committed to collect where the person or persons from whom such fees appears to be due, produce the former Sheriffs receipt or otherwise make appear payment of the same under the forfeiture and penalty of Treble the same Exacted to the party or parties, provided to be recorded with Cert in any Court of Record within this Province by Bill Plein or Information whereupon no Writ of Habeas Protection or Writ of Habeas Corpus shall be allowed and forasmuch as Sheriffs Bonds have of late years been usually taken in the County Courts for the better convenience of the Sheriffs getting security without any belon forms thereof prescribed & it therefore Enacted that all Sheriffs Bonds hereafter to be taken throughout this Province to be made in manner and forms following. —

Bond Form Maryland. We here all men by these presents that we A. B, C. D, and E. F. of the County of G. in the Province aforesaid are holden and firmly bound unto his Sacred Majesty King William the 3. &c. in the full true and just quantity of Two hundred Thousand pounds of good Law Merchantable lawful Tonnage and passage to be paid to his said Majesty his Heirs and Successors To the which payment well and truly to be made we bind our selves our heirs our or either of our Heirs Executors and Administrators Jointly and severally for the whole and in the whole
