

Soldiers do range in and about the said Province
 in the Boundry thereof to tend at his Excellency his present
 and the Hon^eble the Council and the Committee hereafter appointed
 shall see Provision to Continue the said Rangers and that in
 Said Rangers shall be allowed the sum of two shillings and six
 pence for each Trooper a day by finding their horses horses
 and provisions and that the two Commanders be paid in money
 proportionately after the same Rate and that each foot Soldier
 finding themselves Provisions also be allowed eighteen pence per
 day to be paid by the Treasurer of the Western Shore **AND**
 be it further enacted by the Authority aforesaid by and with
 the Advice and Consent aforesaid That Thomas French Esq^r provide
 for the said Rangers the Quantity of Six hundred weight of
 Pork and one thousand weight of Biskott to be deducted out
 of the said Rangers pay and to be paid to the said French by the
 aforesaid Treasurer. And be it also enacted by the Authority aforesaid
 by and with the Advice and Consent aforesaid That the said Rangers
 and foot Soldiers be Exempt from during the time of their such Actual
 Service and such Ammunition during such their Actual Service
 as their Affairs shall require shall be allowed them off public
 charge of this Province and that they the said Troopers day
 Range and in case any of them be found to straggle about
 Plantations and not performing their duty ^{there} shall lose their
 pay and be further punished at the discretion of the said
 Commander and that the foot Soldiers be quartered with
 frontier Plantations at the discretion of Col^l John Addis
 the Commander &c. And be it further enacted by the
