dians to satisfy and continue the League  
formerly made with them and to enter into such further  
Articles as by His Excellency the Governour and Council  
and Committee here after appointed shall propose to them  
and that a present be given to the said Indians And  
that further Enacted by His Excellency aforesaid by & with  
the Advice and Consent aforesaid, That Cap<sup>t</sup> Richard Hill  
Mr. Samuel Young, Mr. George Sherman, Mr. William  
Hickinson, Mr. Thomas Greenfield Mr. Victor Smith Mr.  
Elisha Hall, Mr. Peter Fiskin, and Mr. Benjamin  
Hall the Major part of them be appointed a Committee  
to Joyn with His Excellency the Governour and His Majesty  
his Council in Advising and Comforting such Inha-  
bitants as will suppress any Violence which may be offered  
to this Province by the said Indians after the breaking up of  
this present Session of Assembly until such time as the  
said General Assembly can possibly be convened and  
what shall be thought expedient and done by the  
Governour and Council with the Advice of the said Committee  
is hereby allowed and confirmed by this Generall  
Assembly this Act to endure till the next Session of  
Assembly and no longer.

An Act prohibiting the
