

Provinces are hereby authorized and empowered
to sufficient Number of freeholders good and lawfull men
to serve on a Grand Jury in the County Courts of the Provinces
Yearly at the least that is to say at March and November
if need require at the discretion of the Justices of the
County and to summon the said Grand Jurors ten days at least
before each Court for which service the Justices of each respective
County Court shall and are hereby empowered to make such
reasonable Allowance as to them shall seem that not exceeding
the Sum of four hundred pounds of Tobacco each Court and the
said Sheriffs neglecting their Office and Duty herein as aforesaid
shall for every such Offense forfeit and pay the Sum of two
hundred pounds of Tobacco and the Party or Parties refusing
to serve when Legally Summoned shall forfeit and pay the Sum
of two hundred and fifty pounds of Tobacco and the like shall
be levied upon all Petit Jurymen Legally Summoned who shall
be Legally Qualified as is before in this Act recited and
provided **And** be it Enacted by the Authority aforesaid that
all and every the fines and forfeitures that shall fall or accrue
by Virtue of this before recited Act shall be paid to our Loving
Lord the King his Heires and Successors for the Support of Govern
Any Law Statute or custom to the contrary notwithstanding
This Act to Endure for three Years or to the end of the next
Sessions of Assembly which shall first happen
