

whereupon Complaint made thereof to the Justices of the
County Court of such Ordinary keeper Misbehaviour
or keeping evil Rude in his House the Said Justices of
the County Courts are Herby Authorised and Impowered
to Suppress such Ordinary keeper and putting in such
Licence And be it further Enacted by the Authority -
aforesaid that any Ordinary keeper Diminished or Suppre-
mpted or any other person that shall presume to keep
Ordinary without Licence first had and obtained aforesaid
shall for every month he arreth shall keep Ordinary as
aforesaid forfeite and pay Two Thousand pounds of Tobacco
one halfe to His Maty for the aforesaid and the other halfe
to him or them that shall sue for the same to be recovered
in any Court of Record within this Province by Bill plaint
or Information wherein no Person protection or Wager of
Law to be allowed AND be it further Enacted by the
Authority aforesaid That no person or persons inhabiting -
within this Province not having Lawfull Licence shall
see by retayle and syde, Quines drink or any other
strong Liquors to be dranke in his house or their houses or
about the same or their plantations upon forfitud
of every time he shal or they shall be lawfully Convict
thereof the summe of one Thousand pounds of Tobacco
one halfe therof to His Maty his heirs and Successors
for and towards defraying the Expens charge aboves
such forfitude shall become due and the other halfe
to the Informer or to him or them that shall sue for
the same to be recovered in any Court of Record within
the Province by action of Det Bill plaint or in
