

Information without no *Exempt* protection or *exemption* -  
 to be allowed and to it further enacted by the authority  
 by and with the advice and consent aforesaid That no Justice  
 persons whatsoever be licensed to keep Ordinary as aforesaid. That  
 refuse to credit any person capable of giving a *Vote* for Election  
 of Delegates in any County within this Province to the Value of  
 Four hundred pounds of Tobacco per Annum for any Accomodation  
 by him Lented whereof any such person so capacitated as aforesaid  
 shall have Occasion of or require to be Accomodated with under  
 the penalty or forfeiture of four hundred pounds of Tobacco  
 by such Ordinary keeper for refusing to credit such person as  
 aforesaid one Moiety thereof to his Majesty his heirs & Successors  
 for and towards the defraying of the County Charge where  
 such forfeiture shall become due the other Moiety to be Inform  
 -ed or him or them that shall sue for the Same to be recovered  
 as aforesaid And whereas it hath been found prejudicial  
 to the Inhabitants of this Province that such Ordinary keepers  
 or Inholders have frequently entertained diverse *free men* &  
 loose persons a great time *drinking* at their houses as well  
 to many other persons great damage as their own Ruine -

Be it therefore Enacted by the authority aforesaid  
 by and with the advice and consent aforesaid That it shall  
 not be lawful for any such Ordinary keeper or Inholder  
 to keep such Ordinary or house of Entertainment unless  
 they have passed before the Justices of each respective County  
 Granting their Licenses a Bond with good security to the Value  
 of Twenty pounds Sterling that they shall not entertain  
 any *free man* or other loose person above Twenty
