brought into the Province and delivered to a Magis-
trate of the County into which they shall be brought
the person so taken shall receive due allowance
by the Master or Owner of such Runaway for the
provision of Tobacco and for the carrying of the
money upon his procuring a certificate from the
Justice or Sheriff of the County of such Runaway -
Except Servant or Runaway returned from Newmarket
