

Be it therefore Enacted by the King most
Excellent Majesty and with the Advice and Consent of His
present Generall Assembly and the Authority of the same that
the said Dorsey his Executors and Administrators be and are
hereby discharged of bunding and finishing the said Intended to
be built Church and that the said Edward Dorsey his heirs Executors
and Administrators shall well and truly make payment of the said
Two hundred pounds and of every part and parcell thereof -
to Mr Robert Mason publick Treasurer of the Western Shore or to y
Publick Treasuro of the Western Shore for the time being to be im-
ployed to such use or uses as the Generall Assembly shall hereafter
appoint and to the End the said of Two hundred pounds may be
most Certainty paid Be it Enacted that if the said Edward Dorsey
do not make his personal Appearance or before the Tenth
day of August next at Annapolis before His Excellency Nathaniel
Basilan Esq and there with Two sufficient Sureties give
Bond or recognizance in His Majesty's Name to the uses aforesaid of
the said sume with condition that the said Edward Dorsey -
shall pay the said Two hundred pounds within Two Years next to
Come after this present Session at Two severall Equal payments to
the Publick Treasurers as aforesaid &c that His Majesty's Attorney
Generall at the Command of His Excellency shall cause the said sume of
Two hundred pounds to be arrested and levied in His Majesty's Name
to the uses aforesaid as if the said sume had been Committed
in the Provinciall Court before the Justices of the said Court
and to be paid to the publick Treasurers as aforesaid to be accomplished
Heretore to the Generall Assembly. And whereas Henry Coles a
Bricklayer and Thomas Hilder Carpenter Engaged to the said
Edward Dorsey by Covenant to undertake no other Considerable
business
