

Be it therefore Enacted by the Lays most  
Excellent Maty by and with the Advice and Consent of his  
present Generall Assembly and the Authority of the same that  
the said Dorsey his Executors and Administrators be and are  
hereby discharged of building and finishing the said Intended to  
be built Chappel and that the said Edward Kirby his former Executor  
and Administrators shall well and truly make payment of the said  
Two hundred pounds and of every part and parcel thereof -  
to Mr Robert Mason publick Treasurer of the Western Shore or to  
publick Treasurer of the Western Shore for the time being to be Im-  
ployed to Gods use or uses as the Generall Assembly shall hereafter  
appoint and to the End the said Two hundred pounds may be  
most conveniently paid Be it Enacted that if the said Edward Kirby  
do not make his personal Appearance on or before the tenth  
day of August next at Annapolis before his Excellency Nathaniel  
Price Bishop Esq and his two other Suffitient Justices give  
Bond or recognizance in his Matys Name to pay unto aforesaid  
double the sume with condition that the said Edward Dorsey -  
shall pay the said Two hundred pounds within two years next to  
come after this present Session of the General Equal payment to  
the Publick Treasurer aforesaid &c That then his Matys Attorney  
General at the Command of his Excellency shall call the said sume of  
Two hundred pounds to be demanded and exacted in his Matys name  
to the aforesaid as if the said sume had been Comendred  
in the Procurerall Court before the Justices of the said Court  
and to be paid to the publick Treasurer aforesaid to be remitted  
therefore to the Generall Assembly And whereas Henry Coffey a  
Bricklayer and Thomas Hender Carpenter Engaged to the said  
Edward Dorsey by Tenant to undertake no other Consideration
