

Every of any Books, Marriages or Burials made
with any Clerk of any County Court according to directions
of such Laws as were then in force before any of these Laws
were in being And that the Rec^d of each Parish may be
enabled to performe the charge hereby required of this
Be it Enacted by the Authority aforesaid and
consent aforesaid that if there be any Vestryes of any
Parishes that have not already provided good and sub-
stantiall Writing Books with bound Suffreints for
Recording such proceedings in according to the direction
of the former Laws that in every such case of such neglect
or Omission the Vestry of such parish shall at the first
charge provide such Booke or Bookes within five Months
from the end of this Session of Assembly under the Penalty
of five hundred Pounds of tob^o each Vestryman (The
Minister only Excepted) neglecting as aforesaid to
our Sovereign the King for the uses therein mentioned
And that there may be no neglect in the Vestryes
or those employed under them in the carefull and conscio-
-nable Performances of their severall Duties in this
Laid contained the said Vestryes are hereby Obliged to
meet frequently or as often as need shall require upon
Notice Given by the Principall Vestrymen of each
Parish to consult of the method and way of perform-
ing the severall Authorities reposed in them and from
which Vestryes soe appointed no Vestrymen without law-
full impediment shall Absent himselfe under the Penalty
of One Hundred pounds of tob^o to each Vestryman
willfully neglecting to appear as afo^r and under the same
Penalty to such Principall Vestryman who shall not appoint
such Vestry to meet when need shall require such Omissions
neglected to be noted in the Vestry Register of Recordings
