

And whereas in the said name and the said Statute and
 two Vestries are hereby further enjoined that where there
 is not Tables of Marriages already set up in their respec-
 tive Parish Churches with all convenient speed and
 within Six Months at the next to procure of said Tables
 of Marriages transcribed and set up in their respective
 Churches and the same keep continually in the said Churches
 that now being thereby informed what marriages are for-
 gotten may avoid the contracting any such unlawful
 Marriage and that the said Vestries do once every Year
 in or about the Month of January yearly make choice and
 appoint two sober and discrete Freeholders of their respective
 Parishes to be Church Wardens for that Year upon penalty of
 Two Hundred Pounds of lawful Money (except however
 accepted) notwithstanding either in the Table of Marriages or appoint-
 ing Church Wardens to our Sovereign Lord the King as aforesaid
 which Church Warden so chosen shall take the usual Oath
 and likewise declare on his oath given by the Vestry well
 faithfully to execute that Office during the ensuing Year ac-
 cording to the best of his knowledge any such person or persons so
 chosen Church Warden or Wardens that shall wilfully refuse
 to serve in the said Office and take the Oath aforesaid shall be
 fined One Hundred Pounds of lawful Money to our Sovereign Lord the King
 and the Church Warden and Vestry are authorized and required
 to take diligent care to satisfy and pay the necessary charges
 and of all necessary repairs and Amendments of the respective
 Churches Chappels or Church Yards and cause the same at all
 times to be repaired and Amended as need shall require and
 satisfy and pay for the same out of the profits of the same or
 out of such other goods and
 Goods.
