

Good Charters or Credits as shall come to their hands
 For the Church or Parishes use of those being Minister
 Instituted therein and the Vestry have not any effect in
 their hands besides the forty of Pells to pay Parochiall
 Charges as aforesaid or to make such necessary charges
 as is required there and not otherwise it shall be Lawfull
 for the Justices of the respective Parishes upon application
 of such Parishes Vestry and Church Wardens to Assess the
 respective parishes by a certain Sum of Pells not exceeding
 Ten Pounds of Pells by the pole in any One Year which
 Assessment made by such County Courts and Certificated
 under the County Seale shall be sufficient to the Sheriff
 of such County to Levy such tax by the pole on the In-
 habiters of such parishes in the same manner as other publick
 dues are Levied and shall not deduct Above five Per
 Cent for his Salary and pay the said to such Vestry
 for the use aforesaid and to the intent that this Act may
 Answer the end of the makers which is that his Majesty
 good Subjects of this Province may be instructed in Religion
 and therein of their duty to God his Majesty and themselves
 and those Idle and Exemplary persons that shall labour
 therein suitably provided for Be it enacted by the Authority
 of this present Parliament that no Minister or incumbent
 shall at one time hold more then two parishes nor two
 parishes but by the desire and Agreement of the Vestry of
 said Adjacent Parishes and consent of the Vestry where he
 resides and the Appointment of his Grace the Governor or other
 Person Legally Authorized thereunto for the time being nor
 Claime other or larger Part of the forty of Pells than what
 such Adjacent Parishes shall consent and agree with him to
 pay yearly, And it is the true intent and meaning of this
 Act that what Summe or Summes of money Abbacoe goods
 Charters or any other Interests except Land given to the
