 severall Vestrymen of each respective parish may not be discouraged
 to looke after any thing that by any means at aforesaid becometh
 the parishes right and due. Be it Enacted by the Authority aforesaid
 and consent aforesaid that in any Action by them commenced
 in the name of the Vestry and for the benefit of the Parish aforesaid
 they shall not be obliged to pay any fees or costs of Suits to any
 Person or Officer unless they recover in the said Actions nor pay
 Defendant any Cost in case the Vestry shall not recover or be cost in
 such Suits and that the May Parke of the members of every Vestry
 shall be construed the Vestry capable to proceed in any Matter and if
 where there are not or shall not be ministers in any Parish it shall
 and may be lawfull for the Vestry to provide some sober and discreet
 person as a Reader and agree with him for such service for
 yeare or otherwise for less time and allow him his pay out of
 the forty per pole what parte thereof they shall agree for not exceeding
 the one halfe yearely of such Revenue and upon such reading
 taking the said Oath appointed by Act of Parliament Subscribing
 the test and Association and procuring a License from His
 Majesty
