A. Log-keeper and shall be liable to restore forfeited
and suffer such corporal pains as by the first Officer in this
Act mentioned and to prevent any such person from conceal-
ing or disfiguring the marks of Limes killed as aforesaid
To be it further enacted that if any person shall
kill any such unmarked Limes in the woods or other
and shall wilfully disfigure the marks or cut off the Limes
of such Limes so as to conceal the true and real marks
or whether it were marked or not shall be deemed and adjudged
a Log-keeper within the purview of this Act and shall
suffer accordingly and to prevent the abusing hunt-
ing or worrying any flock of Hogs, cattle or horses with
Dogs or otherwise To be it enacted that if any person
or persons whatsoever that have been convicted of any of
the Crimes aforesaid or other crimes or of Willful and dis-
obedient Proving that shall Theob. kill and hunt upon any
Land whereon there shall be a seated plantation without the
Owners leave having been enquired before Warned shall
forfeit and pay One thousand pounds of 1000 and half to
our Sovereign Lord the King the other half to the party
Grieved or those who will sue for the same to be recovered
as aforesaid and the better to imprint the meaning and Pen-
alty of this Law into the minds of all sorts of People and to
prevent the committing any such Crimes and Offences as
aforesaid. To be also enacted that this Act shall be published
read seven times a year in every Parish church of this
Kingdom at the time of a full congregation either before or
after served by the Clerk or reader of such Church under the
Penalty of One thousand pounds of 1000 forfeit to our
Sovereign
