

It is enacted and shall be made to reforme and to
and Suffre such Corporall paines as by the first Article in this
Act mentioned and to prevent any such person or persons conceald
ing or disfiguring the markes or signs lawed as before sayd
So it further enacted that if any person print
killing any such unmarked swine in the woods or other
and shall wilfully disfigure the markes or cuts of the deer
of such swine so as to conceal the true and real markes
or whereto it were marked and shall be deemed and adjudged
a High Treason within the purview of this Act and shall
suffer accordingly and to prevent the abusing Hunt-
ing or Worring any sick or stagg cattle or horses with
dogs or otherwise So it Enacted that if any person
or swine whatsoever that have beene committed of any of
the Crimes aforesaid or other crimes or of willfull malice and dis-
obedient to the King that shall be killed and hunt upon any lands
and where there shall be a stated plantation without the
owners peace having beene and before warned shall
forfeite and pay one thousand pounds of 1000 on halfe 10-
our Sovereign to the King the other halfe to the party
grieved or those who will sue for the same to be recovered
as aforesaid and the taker to imprende the paines and pen-
alties of this law into the mides of all sorts of People and to
prevent the committing any such Crimes and Offences as
aforesaid So it also enacted that this Act shall be published
read four times a year in every Parish church of this
Province at the time of a full congregation either before or
after service by the Clerk or reader of such Church under the
penalty of one thousand pounds of 1000 forfeite to the
Sovereign
