 every Clerk of the Several and respective County Courts of this  
 Province be and are hereby obliged by Officers to deliver unto  
 the Several Clerks of their respective within their Counties a  
 fair Copy of this Act for Publishing and reading as aforesaid  
 And be it further enacted by and with the Authority aforesaid  
 consent aforesaid that this Act made in open Assembly begun  
 and held at the Towne of Annapolis the 25<sup>th</sup> day of June in the  
 Eleventh Year of the reign of our Sovereign Lord King  
 William the third Anno Domini 1699 Entituled an Act for  
 Speedy Tryall of Criminals and Determining their Punish-  
 ments County Courts when presented there all and every clause  
 therein contained is and are hereby Repealed and made voyde.

## An Act for the Present Security of the Frontier Plantations against the Incurions & Violence of Indians

Whereas his Majesty the King has at a late Treaty with  
 the Pucattawag Indians Renewed the Articles of Peace formerly  
 made between the English and the said Indians who thereupon  
 promised to returne againe and settle among us as heretofore  
 and to Observe and performe the said Articles in all points  
 according to agreement but by reason the time appointed  
 for their returne is not yett accomplished and in consideration  
 of their infidelity and the Little regard they have to former  
 promises and Agreements with them made Be it enacted  
 by the Kings most Excellent Majesty and by and with the Special  
 Consent of this present full Assembly and the Authority of the  
 Same.
