An Act for quieting difference that may  
arize between His Maj<sup>ty</sup> Subjects of this Province &  
the severall Nations of Indians of what places soever

Whereas many differences have and may  
hereafter arise and growe between the English and Indians -  
which for want of a speedy way of determining the same many  
great charges and inconveniences have and may happen hereupon  
by the said controversies being brought from the remote parts of  
the Province to be heard and determined before the God and Council  
to the very great trouble of the persons concerned and the pub  
lick charge which to prevent and to give a speedy redress in all  
such matters Be it enacted by the Kings most Excellent  
Maj<sup>ty</sup> and with the Advice and Consent of this Hon<sup>ble</sup> Gen<sup>l</sup> Assembly  
that the Authority of the same that the Officers in this Act  
hereafter mentioned and appointed be and are hereby authorized  
and empowered to hear and determine all manner of Controversies  
and Differences whatsoever that shall or may hereafter happen or  
grow between the English and Indians in private or public  
Controversy not exceeding the Value of Twenty Shillings Sterling  
that is to say) The Cherokee Indians and the English in Swains  
County and the parts adjacent North forer and Lower Swain  
and for the Creek Indian and Yamoukey Indians  
and the English in Gauley and Prince Georges County and the  
parts adjacent to In<sup>o</sup> Addison M<sup>o</sup> Westons and Major
