An Act for quietting differences that may
arise between his Majt Subjects of this Province &
the severall Nations of Indians of what place soever

Whereas many differences have and may
perchance Arise and growe betwix the English and Indians -
which for want of a speedy way of determining the same may
great charges and illconveniences have and may happen thereupon
by the said controversies being brought from the remoter parts of
this province to be heard and determined before the Gov and Councill
to the very great trouble of the persons concerned and the pub
liek charge which to prevent and to give a speedy redress in all
such matter Be it Enacted by the Kinges mch D^r May -
By and with the Advice and Consent of this his present
Coy and the Authority of the same that the officers in this act
hereof mentioned and appointed be and are hereby authorized
and impowered to hear and determine all manner of Controversies
and Differenes whatsoever that shall or may hereafter happen or
grow betwix the English and Indians in severall severall
Controversies not exceeding the bounds of County Milling & Herling
(that is to say) the Choptico Indians and the English in Maryland
County and the parts Adjacent Ralph Foster and James Brown
and for the Deeskirk Piscataway and Paganonkey Indians -
and the English in Charles and Prince Georges County and
parts Adjacent By the Addition of Mr Hutton and Major
