By the Authority aforesaid that all and every the persons in  
this Act before mentioned be and are hereby authorized and  
Empowered upon hearing or determining any such difference  
or Controversy as aforesaid and Judgment thereupon given  
either party refusing to perform the same then and in every  
such case the person or persons so empowered shall by way of  
distress take into his Custody the goods and Chattels of the  
Offender and out of the same make full satisfaction to the party  
Wronged at the discretion of the person so authorized and by  
this Act empowered and the Overplus to return to the Owner  
thereof And be it further enacted by the Authority aforesaid  
that if any such difference shall happen between the English &  
the Indians in this Province where particular persons are not  
herein nominated and appointed to hear and determine the  
same As aforesaid that then and in every such case the whole  
Justice of Peace is hereby Empowered to hear and determine the  
said difference according to the rules & methods herein prescribed.  
And be it further enacted by the Authority aforesaid that  
in case of death or Absence of any the persons in this Act nomi-  
nated and appointed that then it shall and may be Lawfull for the  
Gov<sup>r</sup> for the time being to nominate constitute and appoint one  
or more in his or their stead and place who shall hereby have
