

And in such case of Death or Resignation or other Legall  
Discharge, from serving the remaining part of such Vestry,  
shall w<sup>th</sup> all convenient speed Summon & Appoynt a Generall meeting  
of all the Inhabitants of the said Parish; Who are Freeholders  
within the same Parish; and Contribute to the publick Taxes &  
Charges of the said Parish; who shall by Majority of Voyces Elect  
and Choose one or more Sober and Discreet Person or persons -  
Freeholders of each respective Parish; To supply such Vacancies  
And such persons or persons soe Elected and Chosen, shall take  
the usual oaths appoynted by Act of Parliament, instead of the  
Oaths of Allegiance and Supremacy; And the following Oaths (viz<sup>t</sup>)  
I doe Solemnly Swear and Declare that I will Justly and truly Execute  
the Trust or Office of a Vestryman of this Parish; According to my best  
Skill and Knowledge; w<sup>th</sup> out partiall Favour or Affection in said Oaths  
at the Election of a New Vestry and to be Administered by any Justice  
of the Peace of the County; City or place; where such Vestry is  
who is hereby required and Impowered to Administer the same &  
And upon Elections Afterwards, either by Justice of Peace as a  
foresaid or the first Vestryman who is hereby likewise required &  
Impowered to Administer the same; And each person soe Elected and  
Chosen; shall likewise subscribe the Test: And also the Association  
and having soe Done; and not before shall be Deemed and taken  
as one of the Vestry: To all intents and purposes. And it is hereby  
further ordained & Enacted by the Consent and Authority aforesaid  
that two new Vestrymen shall be Annually Chosen in the places  
of two others who shall be ~~out~~ out; To w<sup>ch</sup> purpose all the  
Inhabitants of every Parish being Freeholders within the same  
Parish; And contributing to the publick Taxes; and Charges there  
of; or such of them as shall think fitt to Attend; shall repair to  
their respective Parish Churches; every year successively upon  
Easter Monday: And there by their Free Choyse; determine what  
two persons shall be Discharged from their being Vestrymen; And  
Choose two others; Qualified according to the present Act; in their
