as the Law requires of such Variants directs: And upon such Requestes taking
the aforesaid Clerks Appointed by Act of Parliament: Subscribing the
The Test and Oration; and pronouncing Sentence from the Ordinary. Shall

given thereof: at which time and place; the Major part of the Vestrymen
shall present (and as such Majority be not under the number of three persons)
Shall constitute a Vestry: And shall have full power to ordain Direct and
Act in all things: by this Act Appointed: To be done According to this Act: as
a Vestry, And that in case any Vestryman shall remove or withdraw him-
self from the parish for Voluntarily or Frequently neglect to give his
Attendance: and Obey the command of the Vestry otherwise before
impeach or incapable to continue to execute the said Office or furnish that
it may suffice the residue of the said Vestry or the Majority of them
