

To y^e taking of Oaths; and all protestant Dissenters whatsoever as
to all discharges and Exemptions from penalties or forfeitures upon
Oath of their Dissenting Separate meetings or other matters wherein
Toleration and ease is granted: To protestant Dissenters by one Act
made in the first year of the reign of his present Maty and his
Late Consort Queen Mary of Blessed memory intituled an Act for
Exempting thire Maty protestant Subjects Dissenting from the Oaths
of Eng^d from the penalties of Cert Lawes; And by another Act made
in the 7th and 8th years of the Reign of his present Maty: intituled
an Act that the Solemn Affirmation or Declat of y^e people called Quakers
shall be Accepted instead of an oath in the usual form; shall have
the full benefit of all Exemptions ease and Indulgence by the said Acts
granted and allowed according: To y^e true intent and meaning of the 3^d Act
they respectively confirming themselves in thire meeting and Assembling
And in all other things to y^e ord^r & rules enjoined by the said Acts in this
Alteration only that y^e Sewall things required or appointed by the 3^d Act
to be done: by or at y^e Gen^l or Quarter Sessions of y^e peace or any
other Court whatsoever or by or ^{two} to any one single Justice of the peace
shall be done by: to and at y^e respective County Courts of this Province
within whose Jurisdiction y^e matter shall fall out; and before: to or by
the Justices of the same; And that the Sewall places used for Religious
Worsh^{ip}: by any such Dissenting Congregation or Assembly shall be Certified
into and Registered at y^e County Court: in y^e same manner; as is by the
said first mentioned Act appointed to be done: To y^e Bishops of the Dioc^h:
The Arch Deacon of the Arch Deaconary: and the Justice of y^e peace
At thire generall or Quarter Sessions. PROVIDED also and
be it further Enacted: that one Act made at a Gen^l Assembly; begun
and held at y^e port of Annapolis the 26th Day of April 1700 intituled
an Act for y^e Service of Almighty God: and Establishm^t of Religion
in this Province according to y^e Church of Eng^d: Be and is hereby
repealed and made void
