

To y^e taking of Oaths, and all protestants Detentives whatsoever as
to all distinctions and Exemptions from penallyses or forfeitures upon
Act^t of their Desenting Separated meetings, or other matters wherein
Collerated and ease is granted. To protestants Detentives by one Act
made in the first year of the reign of his present Maty. and his
late Consort Queen Mary of blessed memory Entituled an Act for
Exempting thare Matthes protestants Subjects Detentives from the Church
of Eng^t from the penallyses of Corp Laws; And by another Act made
in the 7th and 8th y^e r^t of the Reign of his present Maty. Entituled
an Act that the Solemn Affirmation or Declaration of y^e people called Quakers
shall be accepted instead of all oaths in the Usual forme; That have
the full benefit of all Exemptions ease and indulgence by the said Acts
granted and allowed according: To y^e true intent and meaning of the sa^e Act
they respectively confirming themselves in thare meeting and Assembling —
And in all other things to y^e ord^r & rules Enjoined by the said Act^t in this
Alteration only that y^e several things required or appoynted by the sa^e Act^t
To be done: by or at y^e Court or Quarter Sessions of y^e County or any
other Court whosover or by or to any one Justice of the peace
shall be done by: to and at y^e respective County Courts of this Province
within whose Jurisdiction y^e matter shall fall out; and before: to or by
the Justices of the same: And that the several places used for Religious
Worshipp by any such Detenting Congregation or Assembly shall be Certificated
into and Registered at y^e County Courts in y^e same manner as is by the
said first mentioned Act appoynted to be done: To y^e Bishopps of the Diocese
The Ch^rch Deacon of the Ch^rch Deaconry: and the Justices of y^e Peace
At thare generall or Quarter Sessions. PROVIDED also and
be it further Enacted: that the Act made at a Gen^e Assembly, begun
and held at y^e Town of Annapolis the 26th Day of April 1700 Entituled
an Act for y^e Province of Maryland God: and Establishm^t of Religion
in this Province According to y^e Ch^rch of Eng^t: Be and is hereby
repealed and made void
