 further I give my Son John Mann one bay young horse or gelding, one
 and Colts: One feather bed, and bolster the books he had with him, the
 the books I sent Mr^d Livingston; and all my Law books: And also the
 hundred Acres of Land out of the Tract I had of pipes to be Allowed
 by the above Mr^d Smithson and you Mr^d Postard: if he shall come to settle
 in this Country to be delivered at Demand the whole: if in case he dies
 without Issue and my Land in England should Descend to my Daughter Dany
 then after the Decease of my wife my Land I now live on to be Equally
 Divided between my three younger Daughters and Children of them that shall
 be lawfully begotten on them the Male taking place first: all the rest
 of my Land and also not before bequeathed to my Dear and Loving Wife
 during her life not to be disposed out of the housing Orchards: (Pear
 grounds and esse I now live on and enjoy having your Assistance in the same
 if needfull; and by all means to Oblig- all to live in love and unity; To witness
 I have interchangably Set my hand and Seal this Nin- and Twentieth day of
 May 1689

At all times and in all places within this his Majties Province and Territories
 of Maryland shall be reputed deemed taken Received and Allowed as the last Will
 of Edward Mann as aforesaid proved and Confirmed; And that all Seizes and
 Dispositions of Land containing therein be of as full force and virtue according
 to Law: as if the said Writing had been in due forme proved by the Oath
 of three or more Witnesses: To have been Signed Sealed Published and declared
 by the said Edward Mann To have been his Last Will and Testaments (any de-
 fault of forme or proofe of the said Writing or any Law Statute or Usage)
 To y^e contrary in any wise notwithstanding
