

That it shall not be lawful for any Druggers within this Province
and ward or otherwise Dispose of any unmarked Hens, Mares, Cows
Cows: which shall not exceed the Age of Three years: any Law Usage or
Custom to y^e contrary Notwithstanding —

And further be it Enacted by the Authority aforesaid: By and with the
Advice and Consent aforesaid: That the Justices in each respective County in
this Province: Shall yearly & every Year within their County Courts twice in
Months of March and November during the Continuance of this Act: cause
to be read in open Court: And likewise give it in charge: By Grand Jurors
to enquire of any Breaches thereof Committed by the Druggers in their County

Maryland: At a sessions of assembly begun and hold at the Town
and Port of Annapolis the Eighteenth day of May and ended the 17th
in the thirteenth year of the Reigne of our soon Lord King William the
third of England the ninth Day of November hundred and one the Hon^{ble}
John Blount Esq^r being Governour were enacted these following
Laws viz^t

That for more speedy obtaining Execution against
those Persons out of the County where Judgment is recovered
against them

That whosoever shall be convicted of Debt in the several County Courts
of this Province to avoid being taken in Execution to satisfy the same
recovered the said Debt frequently fly out of the Jurisdiction of the Court
where he was convicted into the Jurisdiction of some other County Court whereby
Execution is delayed and that no other way hath hitherto been provided
for the Recovery remedy but by laying before the Justices of the provincial Court a
Copy of the proceedings and thereupon having a Writ of Execution awarded
out of the provincial Court which sitting but twice in a Year afford not Remedy
so often as occasion requires for Redress whereof

It is enacted by the Kings most excellent Majesty by and with
the Advice and Consent of their present general Assembly and the Authority
of the same That for more speedy Remedy in such Cases when the person
aforesaid fly out of the Jurisdiction of one County Court into the Jurisdiction of
another that the Justices shall procure a Copy of such Judgment aforesaid
with a Bill of Cost of such Suit and a Certificate under the hand of the Justice of the
County with the Seal of the County where the Judgment was obtained to be
affixed testifying that Execution hath not been done & that they the Justices
