more than what is already raised and likewise to apportion order
and pay out of the publick treasury of this province the sum of
three hundred pounds current money of this province to the several
persons to whom the same shall be due as by the Journals of the
Committee of Accounts appears and a fair Journal of all their
proceedings to be delivered to the Clerk of the Assembly for satisfaction
of all persons therein concerned.

And it is shal. happen that this day that please to convene
an Assembly before the tenth day of October aforesaid then this
present Act and all and every clause therein contained shall be voyd
and of no force.
