An Act for repealing a Law in an act of Assembly
intituled an act for Establishment of Religious Worship in this
province &c. and also for appointing the Oath of Abjuration
to be taken in this province &c.

Forasmuch as the pretended prince of Wales hath for some time and
doth still continue to assume to himself the Title of King of England
and the Dominions therunto belonging by the Name of James the Third,
Therefore for the better Security of her Majesty in her just right and Sovereignty
in and over the province of Maryland and for relinquishing all hopes of
the friends and adherents of the said pretended prince to be upheld
by the Queen most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and Consent
of her Majesty's Governor Council and Assembly of this province and
the authority of the same that from and after the Conclusion of this
present Session of Assembly the Oath of Abjuration shall be Administered
to all Persons of all Ranks Rites or Male hereafter to be admitted to in-
ter in any office or place of Trust within this province in due
Manner and form as is herein after recited That to wit
