AN ACT directing the manner of suing out Attachments in this province and limiting the extent of them. For settling the manner of proceedings on Attachments and limiting the extent of them and providing what shall be doyd done and Executions.

A Note has been made in 1710 without any other than verbal alterations being made

Be it enacted by the Queens most excellent Majesty by and with the Advice and Consent of Her Majestys Governour Council and Assembly of this province and the Authority of the same that from hence forth no Attachments shall be sued out of any Court of this province before a Writ or Summons be first made upon which writ if the party Defendant be an Inhabitant or Dweller in this province and the Sheriff shall return a Non est Inventus or a Summons shall be return in manner aforesaid issue forth against Defendant And if the Sheriff shall upon the second Writ or Summons return a Non est Inventus in Regard An Attachment shall and may in manner hereafter set down be awarded And in Case any Writ or Summons shall
