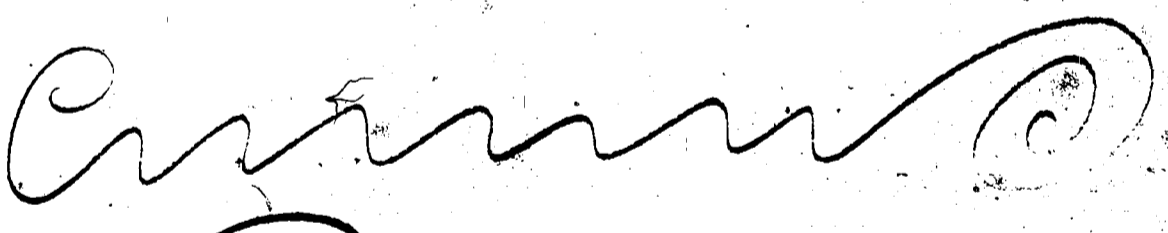

WHEREAS for due Administration of Justice it is  
 the Wills of all persons may be duly proved and the  
 portion of the Estates of persons dying without will may be given  
 persons who have the best right to succeed them and  
 recover and filial portions and expences of Testaments  
 obtained according to the true Intent of the Testaments
