It is enacted by the Queens most Excellent Majesty by and with
the advice and consent of Her Majesty's Governour Council and Jus-
tices of this province and the Authority of the same that the
Judge or Commissary Generall for probate of wills and granting
Administrations shall hold his Court once in two months at the least
or oftner as the case shall require and therein shall proceed according
to the Law of England now in force or hereafter ^{to be} in force within
two months after such Law shall be published in the Kingdom of
England if he shall be soe therein having in such case as by this present
Act is provided and that it shall and may be lawfull for the Judge for
probate of Wills to prove any last will within this province altho the same
concern Titles of Land and ^{usage or} Custom or Statutes of England to the contrary
notwithstanding

And to the end that all shal portions may be secured to the
Children of all persons dying intestate and legacies paid to Legates of
persons making wills for it is likewise enacted by the Authority aforesaid
by and with the advice and consent aforesaid first that the Judge
for probate of Wills and granting Administrations shall call all Ex-
ecutors and Administrators to Account for the Estates of all persons de-
ceased within two months next after Administration committed
And if any Administrator shall ^{refuse} to give an account within the
time aforesaid being lawfully ^{summoned} ~~called~~ that then the said Judge if he see
just cause may write his first Letters of Administration to such Admi-
nistrator committed and shall grant Administration de bonis non ad-
ministratis to some other person as in his discretion he shall think fit
Which said Administrator duly appointed shall give Security as all other
Administrators do and shall sue and implead the former Administrator
before the Judge aforesaid for an account of the Estate of the Intestate And
in case it shall appear to the Judge aforesaid that the former Administrator
hath wasted and misemployed the Estate of the Intestate then the Judge shall
in his bond entered into by the former Administrator and his Security unto
the Administrator to be recovered against them for such Wasting or
