

and right being according to law to have his name who shall enjoy his  
and will be prosecution committing malice and performing all such  
actions and things at his entry thereon as by this act required and  
the said Captain comes to age this 25th day of June 1770 and his  
Sufficiency in possession as aforesaid shall in his name and by his  
such Captain bring his action of <sup>committimus</sup> ~~assize~~ against the former guardian  
for the damages by him committed and <sup>committimus</sup> ~~assize~~ of such effectio-  
nally and now by obliging to give the same in the year of our Lord  
Court to the said Captain July under the penalty of twelve hundred  
pounds of Tobacco and half a pound of Tea to the Majesty the Queen and  
Successors for the Support of Government the other half to him or  
them that shall sue for the same to be recovered in the provincial Court  
by the plaint or information wherein no attorney or wages of  
said to be allowed.

And so it further enacted by the authority aforesaid by and  
with the advice and consent aforesaid that the Governor and his  
Deputy Commissioners which are and shall be in the Province and res-  
pective County within this province shall and are hereby sufficiently  
authorized and empowered to pass and make and allow aforesaid accounts  
as shall come before them relating to the admens & estate wherein they  
have granted letters of admittance ~~and~~ Letters Testamentary  
not exceeding fifty pounds Sterling and to transmit such accounts within  
two months to the Commissary General Officer at Amapotes under the pen-  
alty of two thousand pounds of Tobacco and half to the Majesty for  
the Support of Government and the other party that shall pay such account  
and to hand with the same to the Commissary General for which passing  
such account the said Deputy Commissioner shall be allowed a sum  
of fifty pounds of Tobacco and no more and if the said Deputy  
Commissioner as aforesaid shall exact demand or require of any person what so  
ever more than is by this law for accounting such his Officer allowed him  
he shall be liable to such person and penalty as are included in a certain  
Act for limiting Officers fees in this province but in case it shall happen  
that any person or persons having interest for claim in such estate  
and may be obliged to sue legally or otherwise of any debt due
